Background

Questioning is a multi session support programme for women at the beginning stages of feeling same sex attraction. This group was born from AWC's love and commitment to the Lesbian, Bisexual and Queer women's communities and it is now time to pass this precious programme on to new facilitators. As our agency has previously used all the avenues of funding available for this group, these are both unfunded volunteer positions.

The role

We are looking for warm and empathetic highly skilled facilitators who are out and proud members of the Rainbow community. A lived experience of being a woman attracted to other women is essential as is an inclusive, non judgmental viewpoint and understanding of many of the issues facing women who are attracted to women. The successful applicants will have strong boundaries, be passionate about supporting women to flourish and/or be at peace with where they are at in their rainbow journey. They will also be committed to creating a safe, confidential space for dialogue and questions.

Training

The successful applicants will be trained by our current facilitator during this year's Questioning sessions. This is a wonderful opportunity to work with the fabulous Cissy Rock, to observe the group process, witness the types of questions and dialogue that surfaces and to learn from Cissy's incredible facilitation skills. It is essential that the new facilitators be available to attend on the following dates:
